The range will be operated by a designated Rang Officer who will make themselves known at the range.

General format will be

Allocation of target frame

Validation of rifle being able to hit target at 100m Shooting 200m and beyond after validation Dates: The range is not for casual use but is available for use on the following dates: Currently over the Summer Range is available Sundays (except over Xmas) 11am to 1pm,100yards to 200 yards After which there is a NRA style shoot at longer ranges Range fee is \$10.00
